Request for Proposal

Active Shooter Trainer

Introduction

The City and Borough of Yakutat Police Department, 609 Forest Highway #10, Yakutat, Alaska is soliciting proposals for an Active Shooter Trainer to assist in the 2014 Small Team Tactics and Active Shooter Fundamentals course scheduled for 4 days of training between the dates of September 12th – 30th, 2014 (to be agreed upon between the trainer candidate and the Yakutat Police Department) in Yakutat, Alaska.

Trainer candidates should be familiar with:

- 1) Active Shooter philosophy
- 2) Active Shooter response fundamentals
- 3) Emergency planning
- 4) Decision making
- 5) Command and control
- 6) Mindset and mental conditioning

Course

The subject focus should be Active Shooter response by Single Officers and Multiple Officers. Its design and delivery should be to provide Patrol Officers with proven tools that address the many intricate challenges they may face when responding to an Active Shooter/School Shooting

Scope

The course should be scheduled for 4 full days of training.

Candidates should be certified as an Instructor in Patrol Rifle and/or Pistol recognized by the Alaska Police Standards Council or NRA and should be able to conduct:

- 1) Live Fire exercises
- 2) Dry Fire exercises

- 3) Team Movements and Communication
- 4) Room Clearing exercises
- 5) Fire and Maneuver Drills
- 6) Cross - Cover Tactics
- 7) Live Simunitions Scenario Exercises

Class Environment and materials

Successful candidates should be prepared to instruct in inclement weather.

Training will occur at outdoor ranges, inside of the Yakutat High School, and other structures.

Student to Instructor ratio for the course should be 4 to 1.

Course materials will be approved by the Yakutat Police Department, prior to instruction.
